# Stop the block

When we put items down the sink or the loo that aren't meant to be there, it can cause pipe blockages, which leads to sewer flooding.

Items as small as cotton wool buds or wipes, can cause serious blockages which could result in flooding to your property or in your neighbourhood.

Preventing blockage in your pipes is easy - take a second to think before you dispose of your household items.



If everyone recycles where possible, and disposes of waste in bins, we can all help to keep our sewers clear.

Only the three P's should go into our sewers - pee, poo and toilet paper!

# What can you do in the bathroom?

Use the bin, not the flush.

Put a bin next to your loo to encourage items to be thrown away and not flushed.



Bin wipes, cotton wool and floss.

# What can you do in the kitchen?



Scrape your plates.

Scrape your plates of leftover food into the food bin for composting, before washing your plates or putting them in the dishwahser.

> Use a sink strainer to capture leftover food.

Leftovers, peelings and food scraps should never go down the sink. Use a sink strainer to capture them and then put the waste in a food bin.

Don't pour oil, fat or grease down the drain.

Instead, wait for it to cool and pour it into a recyclable container (such as water bottle) and take it to your local household waste and recycling centre.





Bin all items which are not toilet paper and human waste. Other items will clog the sewers.
